

# Origami Corner Bookmark

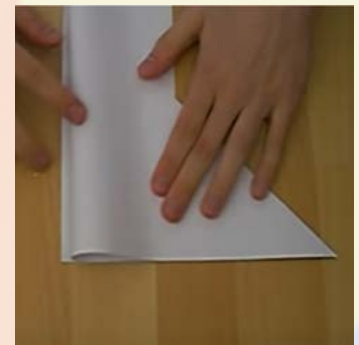


You will need to create a square piece of paper if you do not have origami paper. The first 3 steps will help you accomplish this.

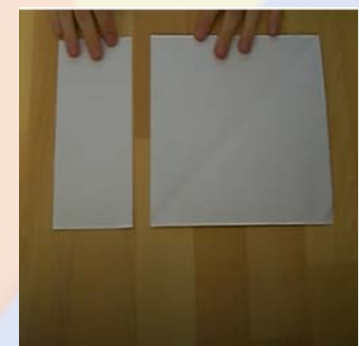
Fold one corner over to the opposite edge of the sheet and make a crease.



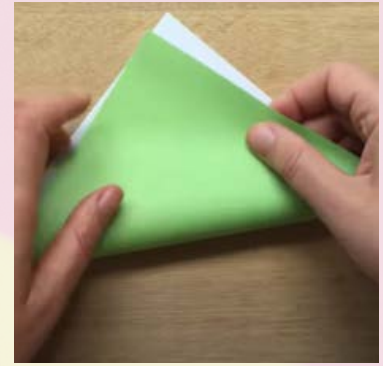
Turn over the paper and fold back the edge to match the edge of the paper underneath.



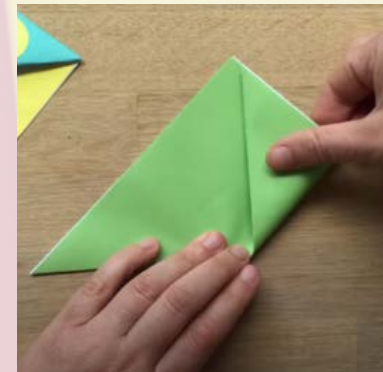
Remove the thin rectangle shape, you have your square and are ready to start.



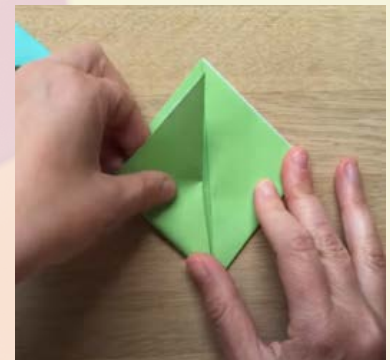
Lay the square paper so there is a point at the top and the bottom. Fold the bottom point up to meet the one at the top. Crease well.



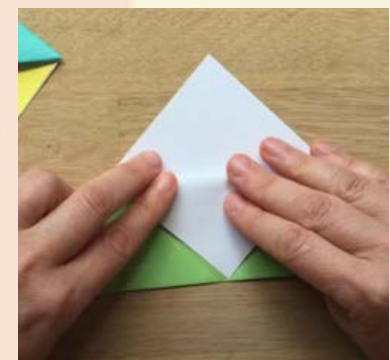
Take the bottom right corner and fold it up to meet the point in the top middle. Crease well.



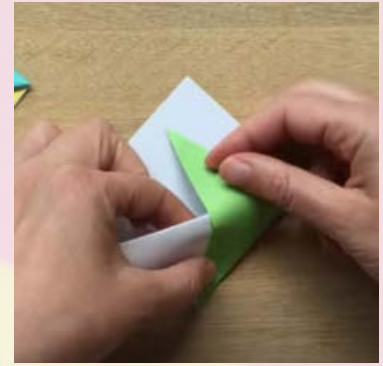
Repeat the previous step with the bottom left corner. Crease well then unfold.



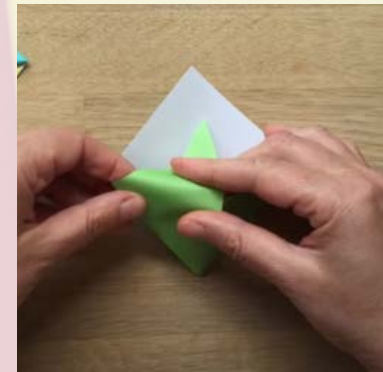
Fold down the top point of the top sheet of paper to where it meets the center of the base of the triangle. The folds you made previously will indicate where the center is. Crease well.



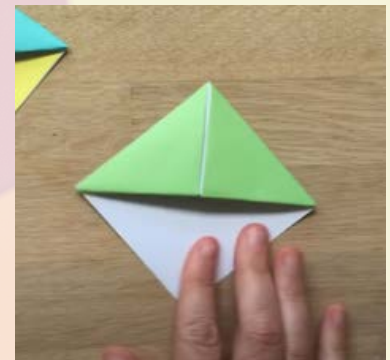
Take the bottom right corner and tuck it behind the fold you just made so the point meets the bottom point from the inside. Crease well.



Repeat the previous step with the bottom left point. Crease well. At this point you have created a pocket.



Spin so the pocket you made is at the top and decorate, if you choose, however you please with markers, pens, gluing on other papers, etc.



Get creative with any supplies you have or can find around the house. Once dried, slip onto the corner or your book to keep your place.
